
### Anti-parasite drugs sweep Nobel prize in medicine 2015

Three scientists who developed therapies against parasitic infections have won this year's Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine. T.

The winners are: William C. Campbell, a microbiologist at Drew University in Madison, New Jersey; Satoshi Ōmura, a microbiologist at Kitasato University in Japan; and Youyou Tu, a pharmacologist at the China Academy of Chinese Medical Sciences in Beijing.

### 13-year-old Odisha girl wins Google Science Fair award

A 13-year-old student from Odisha, Sripada Srisai Lalita Prasida, has won the Community Impact Award at the Google Science Fair in the 13-15 years age category for developing a water purifier that works using waste corn cobs. Prasida, who studies in class 9 at DPS Damanjodi in Odisha's Koratpur district, was awarded \$10,000 as prize money and will be mentored by Google to build the project. As part of the project, Prasida used waste corn



cobs in order to clean purify water from domestic as well as industrial wastes by applying the principle of adsorption.

In her experiment, Prasida found that waste corn cobs are able to adsorb contaminants like salt oxides, detergent, suspended particles, coloured dyes, oil, grease and even some heavy metals.

### e-Thesis@NITR has been ranked 6th among the top repositories in India

e-Thesis@NITR, the institutional Open Access electronic theses repository of our Institute has been ranked 6th among the top repositories in India and 395th among institutions around the world. Similarly, DSpace@NITR—the repository of all intellectual output of NITR is ranked at the 10th place in India and 636th in the world.

This ranking is published in the 17th edition (July 2015) of Ranking Web of World repositories, an initiative of the Cybermetrics Lab, a research group belonging to CSIC (Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas), the largest public research body in Spain.



The **Ranking Web** (Webometrics) provides a list of mainly research-oriented repositories arranged according a composite index derived from their **web presence** and the **web impact** (link visibility) of their contents, data obtained from the major commercial search engines.

#### User Awareness Workshop: VIII on October 14, 2015


