The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) - an initiative of MHRD, outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The methodology draws from the overall recommendations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception". NIT Rourkela secured 12th rank among Engineering Institutes and 46th rank overall.
